Please accept this Letter of Intent to partner with World Relief and other local service providers in the Network of Emergency Trafficking Services (NETS). We understand that the purpose of NETS is threefold: 1) to provide emergency services to pre-certified trafficking victims in the United States, 2) to educate local law enforcement, service providers, and community groups about identifying and responding to human trafficking in the United States, and 3) to facilitate effective anti-trafficking collaboration and coordination among key law enforcement agencies and service providers. We understand the emergency services to include:

- Case management
- Interpretation
- Transportation
- Housing/shelter
- Food/clothing
- Health/medical (including dental)
- Legal representation/advocacy
- Trauma counseling
- Employment assistance
- ESOL

We understand World Relief is the lead agency in NETS, administering the program through a grant from the US Department of Justice's Office for Victims of Crime (OVC). Our specific intention is to partner with World Relief in order to support the capacity and effectiveness of NETS in service-delivery, local training, community outreach and interagency collaboration.

This letter is not intended to be a binding agreement, and will not impose any legal obligation on anyone. However, if it is in the best interest of World Relief, our organization, and OVC, we will formalize our relationship financially and/or programmatically with a Memorandum of Understanding.
