This is to formally request that parole be denied for Anthony Wayne McIntosh who shot and killed Morrow Police Officer Jeffrey M. Phegley in the line of duty on January 21, 1987 during a routine traffic stop. Officer Phegley was 22 years old. He was left to die in the street beside his cruiser.

Inmate McIntosh chose murder over a traffic citation. He should be required to serve his life sentence and not be released back into an unsuspecting society. His brutal and vicious actions clearly demonstrate he has no respect or regard for the law or for human life. Please do not let the ultimate sacrifice Officer Phegley made while protecting his community be in vain. You, the Parole Board, have the responsibility of placing the safety and security of citizens, and law enforcement officers, above the freedom of Inmate McIntosh.

Therefore, we respectfully request that parole be denied to Anthony Wayne McIntosh and that he be required to serve his life sentence.
